The successful candidate will be responsible for overseeing and delivering the coaching programme, coaching a number of sessions with the support of the current dedicated coaching team, working on technique and development of advanced skills and performance.

The role is part-time, approx. 20 hours per week (negotiable.) The successful candidate will be expected to coach at pools at Abbey Stadium, Redditch, Studley Sports Centre in Warwickshire and other pools within a 15 mile radius of Abbey Stadium.

The ideal candidate will:

- Have a high technical understanding to design and produce detailed swim sessions for specific squads,
 - Be willing to keep up to date with future developments in swimming and share this knowledge with the rest of the coaching team,
 - Demonstrate a strong ability to motivate and coach swimmers working closely on technique development,
 - Work closely with coaches, swimmers and their parents, committee and volunteers
 - Attend appropriate competitions,
 - Possess excellent admin skills and computer literacy to compliment the role.

 - Hold Swim England Swimming Coach or ASA minimum Level 2 Swimming Coaching Certificate
